

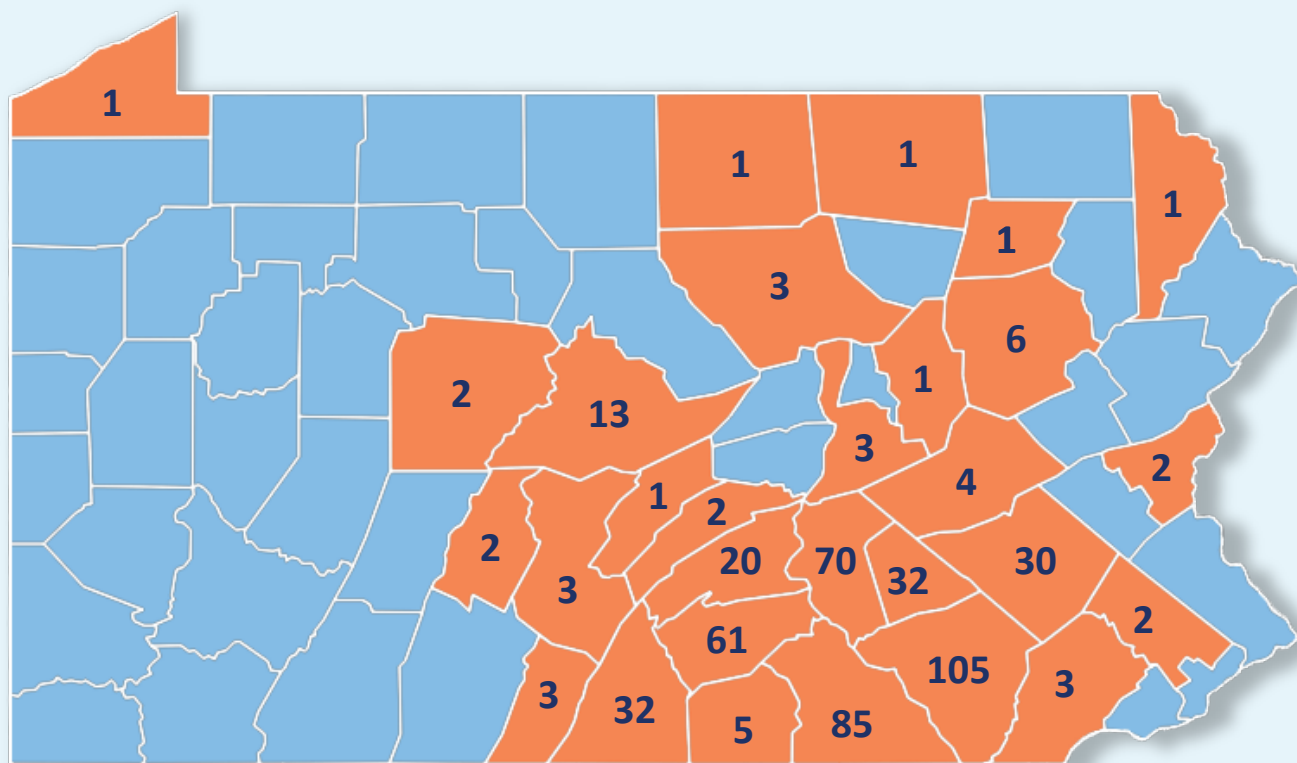


# CHILDHOOD CANCER PATIENTS SERVED IN PENNSYLVANIA BY COUNTY

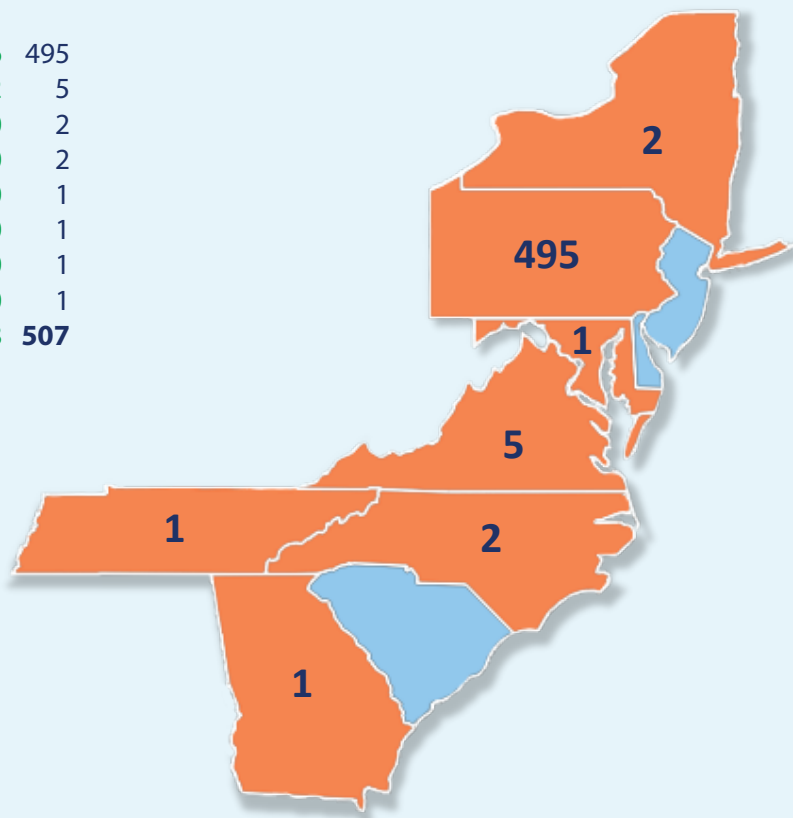
